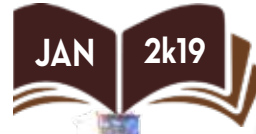

Colossians 3: 10

In 2019, remind yourself that you are always a new creature in Christ. Think about when you accepted Jesus as your Lord and Savior. You joined God's family and became one of His kids. That adoption afforded you many privileges. Now, let's take a look at what the Bible says about your new life in Christ...

A brand new you.

Colossians 3:10: The new man is renewed in knowledge according to the image of Him who created him.

You enjoy freedom, not condemnation.

Romans 8:1-2: "So now there is no condemnation for those who belong to Christ Jesus. And because you belong to Him, the power of the life-giving Spirit has freed you from the power of sin that leads to death."

You have been made right with God.

2 Corinthians 5:21: "For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ."

Resurrection power is yours.

Ephesians 1:19-22: "Understand the incredible greatness of God's power for us who believe Him. This is the same mighty power that raised Christ from the dead and seated him in the place of honor at God's right hand in the heavenly realms. Now He is far above any ruler or authority or power or leader or anything else—not only in this world but also in the world to come.

Begin standing in faith on these scriptures. Read and memorize them. Ask the Lord to reveal their truth to you. Then, thank Him for all the good things you now have access to as a result of your new life in Christ!

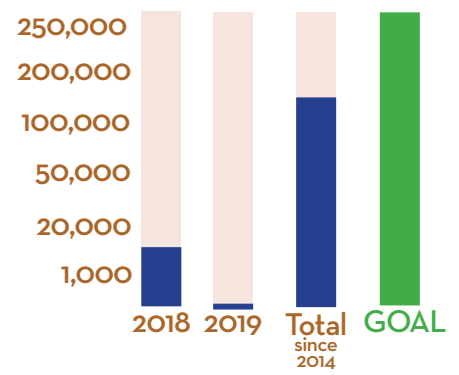

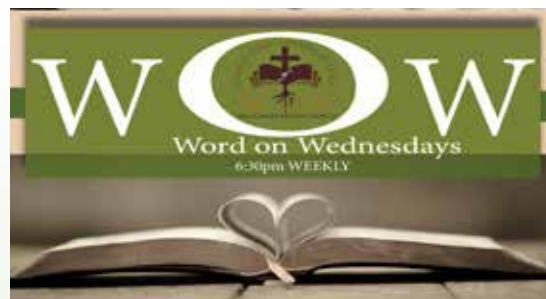

We further engage to watch over one another in brotherly love; to remember one another in prayer; to aid one another in sickness and distress, to cultivate Christian sympathy in feeling and courtesy in speech; to be slow to take offense, but always ready for reconciliation, and mindful of the rules of our Savior, to secure it without delay.

We moreover engage, that when we remove from this place, we will as soon as possible unite with some other church where we can carry out the Spirit of this covenant and the principle of God’s word.

And now unto Him, who brought again from the dead, our Lord Jesus, be Power and Glory forever.
