I am reminded of the words by one of the few African-American Academy Award winners, Denzel Washington. Denzel once made a quote taught to him by his mother that goes, "Man gives you the AWARD but GOD gives you the REWARD." We moreover engage, that when we remove from this place, we will as soon as possible unite with some other church where we can carry out the Spirit of this covenant and the principle of God's word.
