

Grace and peace in the name of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ!

Perhaps you have heard me mention before that *the church is not a hotel for saints, we are a hospital for sinners!* This simply means we are a congregation of people who—on the continuum of our Christian journey—are in need of healing one way or another. We have perfected the art of masking our pain and sometimes we even engage in hurtful behavior towards others. I've come to experience this truth: just because someone is "churched" doesn't mean they are changed!

The Bible calls us to be transformed by the renewing of our mind (Romans 12:2). We serve a God who is able to transform and remake us into His image. He empowers us to live transformed lives. In your quiet time, pause and ask yourself, "Am I allowing God's transforming work to take hold of my life?" So many people grow comfortable with living life as it comes. The great mystic and theologian, Howard Thurman, has a poem that begins, "Give me the courage to live! Really live—not merely exist." In order for us to move away from the pain of the past and present, we must learn how to live!

This month, we are planning a major initiative to help our young people learn to live with hope and purpose at the I AM God's Graffiti Conference featuring author and change agent, Romal Tune. This conference is designed for our youth but is for all of us who desire to help youth and emerging adults find their fit in Christ. We pray that lives will be restored, renewed and redeemed. In order to make this happen, we need you to do the following: (1) Be present for our opening worship on Friday (6/9) and bring a family member or young person from your neighborhood, (2) Sponsor one or several young persons for the conference on Saturday (6/10) who may not be able to cover the donation, (3) Volunteer to serve on our host team to ensure everyone is met with radical hospitality and (4) Pray for our city and our church as we seek to bring the Gospel of Christ to even the most common places in our community.

The events of this past Memorial Day are yet another reminder of how pain and trauma continues to linger in an already traumatized community. Since God has called us into His marvelous light, let us live like children of His light and shine that light in dark places so that we can be the hands and feet of Christ—showing those who hurt that they can find healing. Let's make this conference a success and do all we can to really live while we are yet alive!

## Our Church Covenant (1<sup>st</sup> Sunday)

**Having been led**, as we believe by the Spirit of God, to receive the Lord Jesus Christ as our savior, and on the profession of our faith, having been baptized in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, we do now in the presence of God, Angels and this assembly most solemnly and joyfully enter into covenant with one another, as one body in Christ.

**We moreover engage**, that when we remove from this place, we will as soon as possible unite with some other church where we can carry out the Spirit of this covenant and the principle of God's word.

## On Spotlight ...

### *What Is A Dad?*
