Greetings in the matchless name of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ!

In Joshua 14:6-15, Caleb begins to recall how good God had been to him throughout the years. He was 85 and wanted to testify to others that the same God who was with him as a bold young man is the same God who kept him day-by-day. Caleb's example of faith remains a lesson for us all. He tells the company of witnesses that, through it all, he remained committed (Joshua 14:8). I am certain that the tests and trials were many, but his commitment did not waiver. Verse 10 of Joshua 14 also reveals to us that Caleb had the continuity of God's grace over his life. He was 40 when he left Egypt but

because God's grace continued to strengthen him, he was able to reach 85 with the same strength as his 40 year old self. In other words, he was an example of how to thrive at 85! Caleb fits the description of the famous words by Drake: always down for the cause but never down for the count! He operated in the consistency of his gift.

Because Caleb was committed to God, walked in the continuity of God's grace and demonstrated consistency in his gift, he received a glorious inheritance on earth. The Bible says that Joshua blessed Caleb and rewarded him with the territory of Hebron for his faithfulness to the cause of his God.

We can all learn from Caleb. His boldness at a young age turned into blessedness when he was advanced in his years. In spite of trials and tests, his commitment did not waiver. He stopped negativity and silenced naysayers because he believed in God.

Beloved, it is my prayer that the Holy Spirit helps us all reach our full potential as Caleb did. And if we want The Spirit to do His part, we have to do ours. Like Caleb, be bold to challenge the naysayers and negativity and serve God with commitment and consistency as you experience the continuity of His grace.

10 As each one has received a gift, minister it to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.
11 If anyone speaks, let him speak as the oracles of God. If anyone ministers, let him do it as with the ability which God supplies, that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom belong the glory and the dominion forever and ever. Amen.

Behave Like a Christian – Romans 12:9-18 (3rd Sunday)

9 Let love be without hypocrisy. Abhor what is evil. Cling to what is good.
10 Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love, in honor giving preference to one another;
11 not lagging in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord;
12 rejoicing in hope, patient in tribulation, continuing steadfastly in prayer;



Our Church Covenant (1st Sunday)

We further engage to watch over one another in brotherly love; to remember one another in prayer; to aid one another in sickness and distress, to cultivate Christian sympathy in feeling and courtesy in speech; to be slow to take offense, but always ready for reconciliation, and mindful of the rules of our Savior, to secure it without delay.

We moreover engage, that when we remove from this place, we will as soon as possible unite with some other church where we can carry out the Spirit of this covenant and the principle of God's word.

And now unto Him, who brought again from the dead, our Lord Jesus, be Power and Glory forever.
