Greetings in the Wonderful name of our Risen Savior, Jesus Christ!

The testimony of the resurrection was the foundation for the early church. Those saints were compelled to tell others that Jesus was crucified but He rose from the grave! They were governed by the Holy Spirit and gifted with the wonder and amazement of a Risen Savior, Jesus Christ.

The resurrection is the hope of the Christian believer. The Apostle Peter writes, "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead." Peter stresses that the resurrection gives us hope—a living hope. A living hope is necessary in a dying world. A living hope is critical to maintaining a living faith. A living hope is the kind of hope that can only come from a living Savior.

As the 21st century progresses, we need to maintain the living hope of the resurrection that the 1st century church possessed. The charge of the Commission still remains:

go, teach, baptize and make disciples! The imperative to share the gospel is, perhaps, greater today than it was then. It's Christ who is able to make us new creatures (2 Corinthians 5:17). It's Christ that is able to keep us from falling (Jude 24). It's Christ who overcomes this world of trouble (John 16:33).

The news industry operates with a phrase, "If it bleeds, it leads." In other words, bad news and tragedies are shared by news outlets first because it drives ratings. But the constant onslaught of bad news can wear on the mind and drain the soul. The world needs to hear some good news; and there's none better than the gospel of Jesus Christ!

This April, I pray the living hope of the resurrection compels you to share the good news of our living Savior. Don't let your faith get stale so that you default to dead works. Let your faith remain alive and vibrant that others may be drawn to the light of Christ that shines in your life.



1st Sunday

Christ in Our Place

—Romans 5:6-11—

6 For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.
 7 For scarcely for a righteous man will one die; yet perhaps for a good man someone would even dare to die.
 8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
 9 Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him.
 10 For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.
 11 And not only that, but we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation.

2nd Sunday

The Triumphal Entry

—John 12:12-19—

12 The next day a great multitude that

had come to the feast, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem, 13 took branches of palm trees and went out to meet Him, and cried out: "Hosanna! 'Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!' The King of Israel!" 14 Then Jesus, when He had found a young donkey, sat on it; as it is written: 15 "Fear not, daughter of Zion; Behold, your King is coming, Sitting on a donkey's colt." 16 His disciples did not understand these things at first; but when Jesus was glorified, then they remembered that these things were written about Him and that they had done these things to Him. 17 Therefore the people, who were with Him when He called Lazarus out of his tomb and raised him from the dead, bore witness. 18 For this reason the people also met Him, because they heard that He had done this sign. 19 The Pharisees therefore said among themselves, "You see that you are accomplishing nothing. Look, the world has gone after Him!"

3rd Sunday

He Is Risen

—Luke 24:1-9—

Now on the first day of the week, very early in the morning, they, and certain other women with them, came to the tomb bringing the spices which they had prepared. 2 But they found the stone

rolled away from the tomb. 3 Then they went in and did not find the body of the Lord Jesus. 4 And it happened, as they were greatly perplexed about this, that behold, two men stood by them in shining garments. 5 Then, as they were afraid and bowed their faces to the earth, they said to them, "Why do you seek the living among the dead? 6 He is not here, but is risen! Remember how He spoke to you when He was still in Galilee, 7 saying, 'The Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again.'" 8 And they remembered His words. 9 Then they returned from the tomb and told all these things to the eleven and to all the rest.

4th Sunday

Oh to Know Him

—Philippians 3:7-11—

7 But what things were gain to me, these I have counted loss for Christ.
 8 Yet indeed I also count all things loss for the excellence of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them as rubbish, that I may gain Christ
 9 and be found in Him, not having my own righteousness, which is from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which is from God by faith;
 10 that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death, 11 if, by any means, I may attain to the resurrection from the dead.


